- III. Lynn introduced herself and the board, then gave an update of the happenings within the SCNBA organization. Goodie bags and folders with all of the SCNBA entry forms and copies of the 11/4/17 minutes were distributed for all those in attendance. Lynn informed everyone of the following items:
  - a. This year's scholarship winner was Kylie Shishima, who received \$100.
  - b. The SCNBA lowered the Men's Senior Age to 50, which is the same as the women's.
  - c. The deadline for the orders for the DLC shirts was 2/11/18 at the Doubles Tournament in order to have it by the Roll-off tournament at Action Lanes on 3/25/18. Last year's shirts was purple and blue. This year's new design is not selling as well, most likely due to the lighter color. If you order the shirts online, you will have to pay for shipping.
  - d. The SCNBA will be publishing a commemorative cookbook for the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of merging of the Men's & Women's Associations. The deadline to submit recipes is 3/1/18. Please email a soft copy to [info@scnba.com](mailto:info@scnba.com) or a hard copy to our PO box.
  - e. The Craft fair had 9 vendors last year. This year will be at back at Palos Verdes Bowl on 12/2/18.
  - f. For the first time in the history of the SCNBA, bowler's averages were re-rated based on 3 years of tournament scores. This was not an easy task and took about 3 months to tabulate, however, it was something that needed to be done. Lynn explained what data was compiled and comparisons were made to the entering averages of all the bowlers. There were 10 bowlers were flagged with averages 10+ pins higher than their entering averages. The SCNBA decided to only re-rate the 6 bowlers that were 15+ pins higher. Those names were submitted to USBC to be put on the USBC Re-rate master list.

There was a discussion about the leagues being determined as challenge leagues and sports leagues by the USBC. Lunch was served and then prior to everyone leaving, pictures were taken of the league representatives and officers.
